## DEUTSCHE TELEKOM AG

**History:** Established in Germany in 1990 as Deutsche Bundespost Telekom after the privatization of the existing German Federal Postal Services. As one of the three newly formed private companies, Co. was engaged in telecommunication services, where as the other companies, Deutsche Bundespost Postdienst and Deutsche Bundespost Postbank provide the postal services and the banking services, respectively. On Jan. 1, 1995, Co. became a joint-stock corporation (Aktiengesellschaft) and was listed on the stock exchange in 1996. Present name adopted on Jan. 1, 1995.

In 1991, Co. established DeTeBau for the realization of the investments in structural engineering in the new federal states.

In Jan. 1991, Co. and IBM Deutschland established TeleCash Kommunikationsservice GmbH, a joint venture which was engaged in the marketing of an electronic money transfer system for all economic areas, especially in the services and retail sectors.

In May 1991, Co. established Deutsche Telekom S.A.R.L. in Paris, France, this being its fifth foreign subsidiary in addition to the ones in Tokyo, New York, London and Brussels.

On Aug. 27, 1991 Co. started operation of the INMERSAT (International Maritime Satellite Organization) ground radio station in Raisting. INMERSAT allows its 64 member states worldwide communication and data transfer via satellite with a rate of 64 kbits per second.

On Oct. 29, 1991, Co. and 38 worldwide operating telecommunication companies signed an agreement for the construction of two new transatlantic cables (TAT10 and TAT11). For the first time, one of these cables would connect the United States and Germany directly, increasing the existing capacity by 60,000 telephone channels.

In 1992, Co. acquired an interest in Infonet Service Corp.

In 1992, Co. established a consortium with British Telecom and France Telecom to obtain the licence for a digital CB-Radio network within the pan-European GSM-standard in Hungary.

In Mar. 1992, Co. and Axel Springer Verlag established Video-Tel Infoservice GmbH & Co. KG

On July 1, 1992, Co. established Deutsche Telekom Mobilfunk GmbH (DeTeMobil).

In Nov. 1992, Co. took over an 80% interest in Infonet Network Services Deutschland GmbH.

In Nov. 1992, Co., AT&T and the Dutch PTT formed the joint venture, Utel, for the reconstruction of the telecommunication network in Ukraine

In Dec. 1992, Co. and France Telecom established EUNETcom as a service company for large international customers.

On Dec. 11, 1992, Co., together with Deutsche Aerospace AG and ANT Bosch Telecom, decided to establish a joint venture within the ROMANTIS project, for the development of a satellite supported communication system for the Commonwealth of Independent States.

During 1993, Co. established the 100% subsidiary, DeTe-Berkom.

In 1993, Co. with Siemens AG established SEL/Alcatel AG and in Dec. 1993 with Preussag AG, established Elektrocyling Anlagen GmbH

In Jan. 1993, Co. with France Telecom established the subsidiary, EUNETcom B.V., Amsterdam.

In July 1993, Co. established Deutsche Telekom Asia in Singapore.

In July 1993, Co. with Russian partners, established the joint venture, InfoTel. Co.'s investment totals 25%.

In July 1993, Co., together with ANT Bosch Telecom and Deutsche Aerospace AG, established Romantis GmbH in Bonn.

At the end of Nov. 1993, Co. increased its share in Infonet Services Corp., United States, from 16.7% to 21.6%.

On Nov. 19, 1993, Deutschen Telekom Systemloesungen GmbH (DeTeSystem) was established.

Each outstanding common share of VoiceStream was converted into a right to receive the following merger consideration: 3.6693 shares of Co. and \$15.7262 in cash for former VoiceStream stockholders receiving the mixed consideration, 3.6683 shares of Co. and \$15.9062 in cash for former VoiceStream stockholders who made a cash election and 3.7647 shares of Co. for former VoiceStream stockholders who made a stock election. Each outstanding common share of Powertel was converted into the right to receive 2.6353 shares of Co.
